The Master of Science in Rehabilitation and Mental Health Counseling (MSCRMHC) program offers a rigorous curriculum of coursework and fieldwork experiences designed to prepare graduates for state licensure eligibility and national certification.

The program is fully accredited by the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP) for Rehabilitation Counseling. CACREP has established standards for the accreditation of graduate programs in the counseling fields. These standards are carried out in a number of ways: through continued curriculum development and implementation, by fostering relationships between students and faculty, and competitive staffing of the programs. Students benefit by participating in a program that is nationally recognized for its quality and high academic standards.

All classes are available online except REHA 523 and REHA 590, which are offered live in summer semester. All students are required to attend the three-day live portion of REHA 523 and REHA 590 during summer semester. Students are also required to attend a MSCRMHC New Student Orientation prior to or during their first enrolled semester.
