MART 208 Multimedia Technology. Term Typically Offered: Fall, Spring 3 Credits

Prerequisite(s): CAPP 120, transfer equivalent or consent of instructor.

Students participate in a hands-on environment utilizing recordable CD media, digital cameras, scanners, image capture hardware, digital video recorders, and multimedia editing software.
