MUST 275 Recording Technology I. 2 Credits

Term Typically Offered: Fall

2cr. Introduces students to the basics of the physics of sound, recording techniques, and digital audio workstations Pro Tools and Logic.

2cr. Expands on recording techniques, including the use of audio effects, mixing, mastering, and advanced microphone techniques. Students will also learn the basics of multi-tracking, using Pro Tools and Logic.

MUST 376 Desktop Music Production. 2 Credits

Term Typically Offered: Spring

2cr. Introduces the basics of desktop production and MIDI sequencing. Using tools Logic Pro and Ableton Live, students will learn about MIDI, synthesizers (additive and subtractive), additional plugin use and techniques, and the differences between use of such tools both in-studio and live.
